"This artist is terrified of war. Because he is innocent, he fears guile, lies and deception; and he fears trade and brokerage too. In his view, pale colours reflect, or express, the tragic in human existence. From a technical point of view, he hates bright, vivid colours - they remind him of shiny shoes - and he considers them to be bourgeois colours, used to seduce women. They are mendacious, opulent colours, but people are lured in by flashiness, even if it is also a lie. Don't they see that most artists are using fake jewels, while he goes against showiness, while he goes for the depth of expression? The key factor in this is colour - the subdued colours."




HK: "All your images, not only of birds but also of human figures, are reduced similar patterns of continuous angles and curves. What is the connection?"

Removal of Purchases

The removal of the purchases will be held exclusively in the week following the auction from 10 a.m to 5 p.m from ArtScoops' offices. Removal of purchases will be at the buyer's expense.
